

TRANSFER STUDENT CHECKLIST



We know that transferring to a new school can be a confusing process. Here is a simple list of things to do that will make the transition easier:

1

Apply to Thiel College

Complete the free application online at www.thiel.edu/admissions/apply-online or through the Common Application.

2

Send official records

Have official records sent directly to the Thiel College Office of Admission.

What do I need to submit?

- Official college transcript (s)
- Official high school transcript (if less than 30 credit hours)
- SAT and/or ACT scores (if less than 30 credit hours)

Send Transfer Referral Form

Have the Dean of Students from the last institution attended complete the Transfer Referral Form and send it to the Office of Admission.

Complete or update FAFSA

Complete or update your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov. A completed FAFSA is required in order to receive an official Thiel College financial aid package showing need-based aid, state aid, work study and federal loans.
