**Admission Procedure:**

1. Go to Thiel College Chi Eta Sigma webpage:
  - Download & print two items:
    - a. Chi Eta Sigma Commerce Honorary Application (this form)
    - b. Chi Eta Sigma Commerce Honorary Worksheet
2. Go to Thiel College Self-Service.
  - Download & print a copy of your Thiel College transcript.
3. Review Chi Eta Sigma “Criteria for Admission to Chi Eta Sigma” (above) on the Application to determine if you are eligible to be considered for Chi Eta Sigma membership.
4. Complete Application and Worksheet (to enable you to determine departmental GPA)
5. After completing the Application and Worksheet, if you think you qualify:
  - a. Arrange to meet with the Chi Eta Sigma advisor, Professor John Gomolchak
  - b. Bring three items to meeting with advisor:
    - i. Completed Chi Eta Sigma Commerce Honorary Application
    - ii. Completed Chi Eta Sigma Commerce Honorary Worksheet
    - iii. Copy of Thiel College transcript
