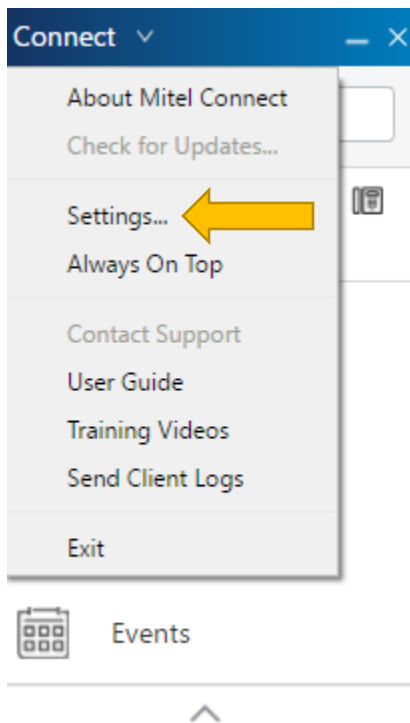


Blocked Nuisance Callers

Open the Mitel Connect app on your pc and sign in.

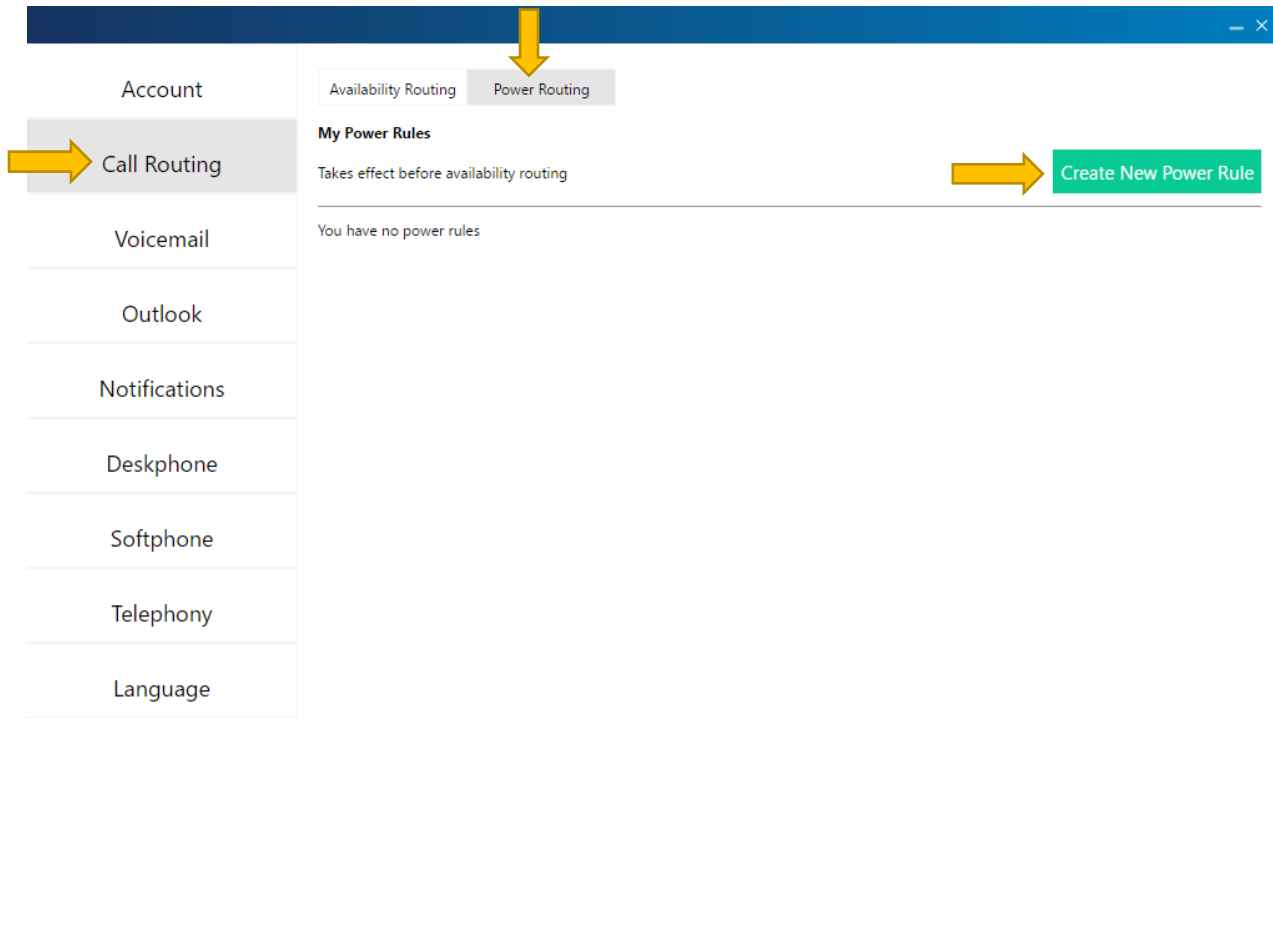


Click on the top left corner of the app to bring down the drop menu. Then click settings



In Settings menu click:

- Call Routing
- Click Power Routing
- Create new Power rule



In this screen:

- Name the rule
- Click number matches
- Then enter the number you want to block
- Under “Then forward call to”: select the 2nd check box and type the extension 2876
