
Homeschool

Applying to Thiel College

Thiel's admissions requirements for homeschoolers are the same as for students who have a traditional background. What differs for homeschooled college students is how your records are obtained. To ensure that your application is processed as quickly and efficiently as possible, your Thiel Admissions Counselor will be with you every step of the way. Your Counselor can even get you started with applying for any financial aid.

Application Requirements

Admissions application

- \$50 application fee.
- SAT, ACT, and/or CLT scores.
- An official high school transcript and any college transcripts which should include the student's course of study and grades.
- Two letters of recommendation from individuals outside the home.
- One essay (see application for the topic).
- Early Decision Academic Data Form or Regular Decision Academic Data Form.

Recommended for Application

- On-campus interview.
- Resume as support for scholarship consideration.
- Interview.
